## Student Group Resources

The MIT Alumni Association is available to consult with student groups in regard to their alumni. FSILGs, athletic teams, and student activities may be particularly interested in forging strong connections with the alumni who participated in those activities during their time at MIT.

### Communicating With Your Alumni

It is our business to keep in touch with alumni. We have a wealth of resources for this purpose. Take advantage of them for your student group.

#### Requesting Alumni Contact Information

We share alumni contact information with student groups for the purpose of alumni relations and fundraising, such as sending out newsletters and event invitations.

#### Creating Alumni Email Lists

There are two kinds of email lists that can be created for your group's alumni relations purposes:

- A discussion list which requires that interested alumni sign up. Anyone can send messages to this kind of list.
- An announcement list which automatically signs up all alumni from your group. Alumni can request to be removed from the list. This list can only have one or two designated individuals that can post messages to the list. (Students designated as Alumni Affairs Officers for their chapters may also post messages to the list.)

### Planning Your Event

#### Consulting for Your Event

Schedule a meeting with our staff during the preliminary stages of your event planning. We can help you plan the registration process—using our SmarTrans online registration tool—recommend caterers and venues, and assist with planning event logistics.
