During this discussion, student leaders and Dean Trujillo will describe the situation nationally and, more importantly, on the MIT campus today. They will explain the variety of effective strategies and resources in place today for reducing risk. Current Alumni Risk Management Advisors will share their approaches and outline how alumni can help. MIT Health Educator Chad Waxman will also contribute his experiences in working with the FSILGs for the past year.

The topic of risk management includes not only curbing substance abuse but also informing approaches to other aspects of community living as well. The session should answer many questions, especially those who are interested in becoming Alumni Risk Management Advisors for their chapters. This is a specific, time-limited role, but one that can really help in young people's unfolding lives. Several FSILG chapters on campus have defined such a role and more plan to do so.
